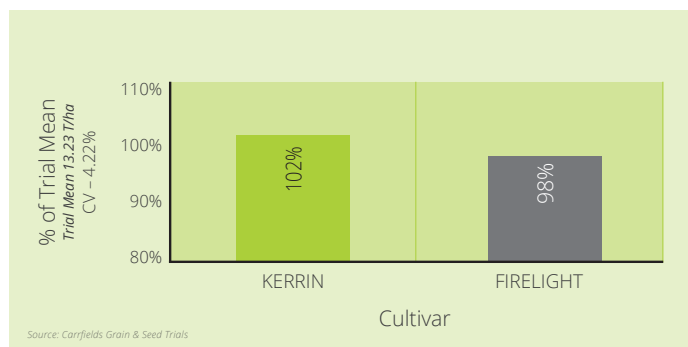


Kerrin is our designated yield champion. With great performance over a wide range of growing conditions, we proudly back Kerrin as a solid variety for your farming operations.
