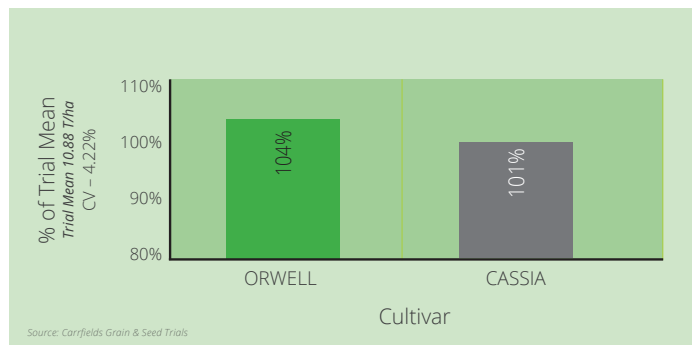


Orwell has several advantages over Cassia, including improved straw strength, better disease resistance, and earlier maturity.
