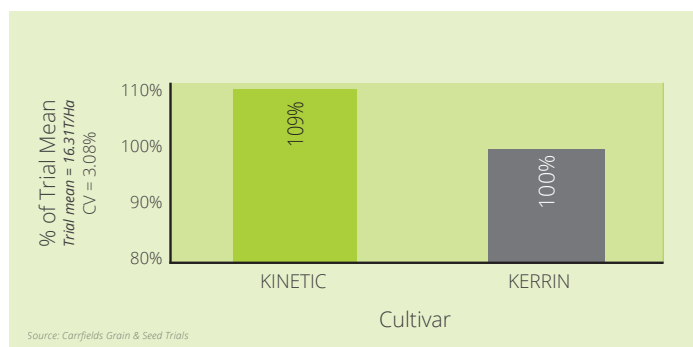


Winter wheat that yields abundantly, matures early, and boasts great resistance to Fusarium.
